

## Quilt Show Challenge!

A Quilt Challenge is an extravaganza of creativity all based around one theme. To participate, you design a quilt that fits the theme - your interpretation of the theme. The completed entries will be displayed together at the 2012 quilt show and the Challenge rules will be posted in the display so that viewers understand the challenge rules, making the display more meaningful. The uniqueness of all the entries when they are all revealed at the show is the best part! Everyone plays with the same theme and rules but, everyone will come out with very different quilts in the end. Secrecy is suggested but not required.

### Theme: "Piecing it all together"

This will be a judged category of TCQG's second quilt show. Entries in the challenge must have a regulation sleeve and have the same deadline as all other quilts for the 2012 Tri-County Quilt show.

In addition quilts for the Challenge Exhibit must also comply with the following guidelines:

- Must reflect the theme of the Challenge "Piecing it all together" – However creative interpretation and artistic license are encouraged.
- Must be made of fabric and be quilted but, embellishment maybe be non fabric provided it does not render the piece unable to hang from its sleeve.
- The piece must be at *least* 12 inches on all sides and maybe as large as 48 inches on all sides. The piece need not be square.
- Must be made by one person
- There must be piecing in the entry but other techniques may be used also
- Entrants are especially encouraged to explain their quilts in this category- explaining why they interpreted the theme in this manner- this is all part of the fun and makes it an interesting display at the show. A space for this is on the entry form.
