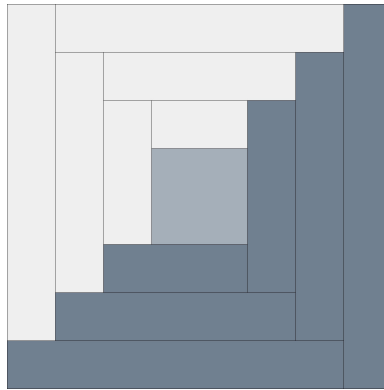


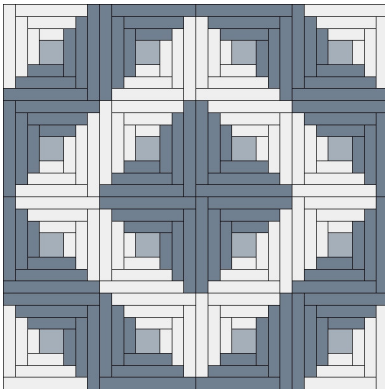
Reuben and the Quilt

Log Cabin Block and Quilt

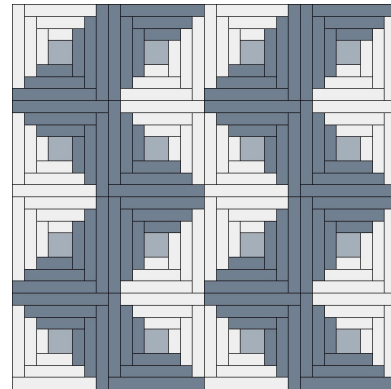
Traditionally, the log cabin block has a red or yellow center square, signifying the hearth of the home. The surrounding 'logs' are usually colored with one side light and one side dark. It forms a diagonal pattern across the block.



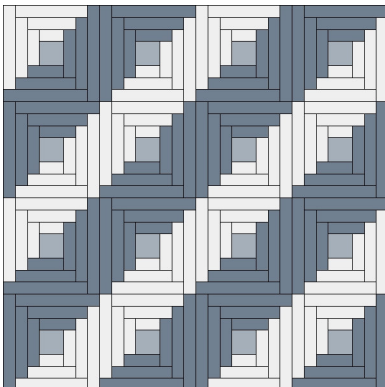
The blocks can then be rotated to form many different patterns such as:



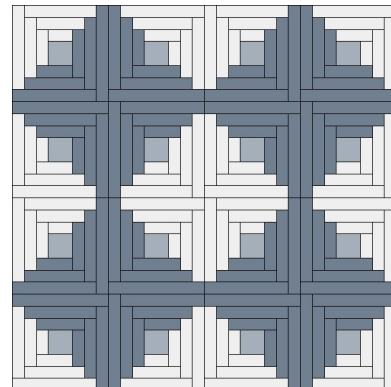
Barn Raising



Streak of Lightning



Straight Furrows



Sunshine and Shadows

Color the blocks so they form one of the above patterns. The dark side of the block can be all one color, or many different colors, just so they all look dark. The light side of the block can be all one color, or many different colors, just so they all look light compared to your darks. You can even cut them apart to form different patterns!
