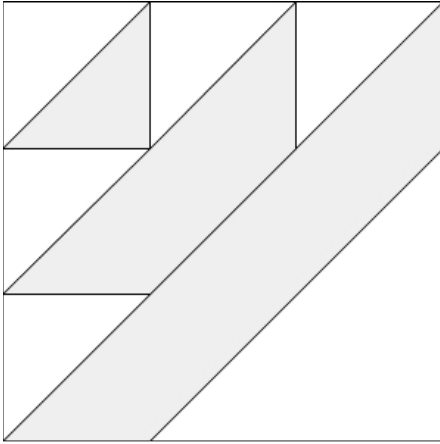
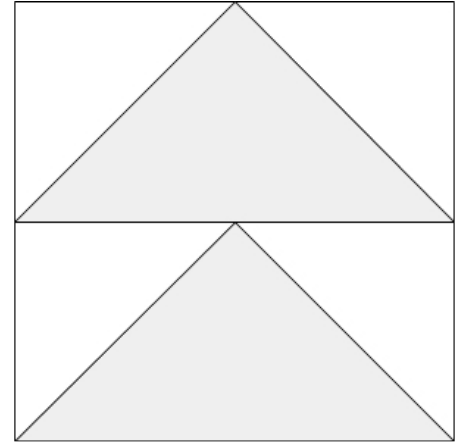


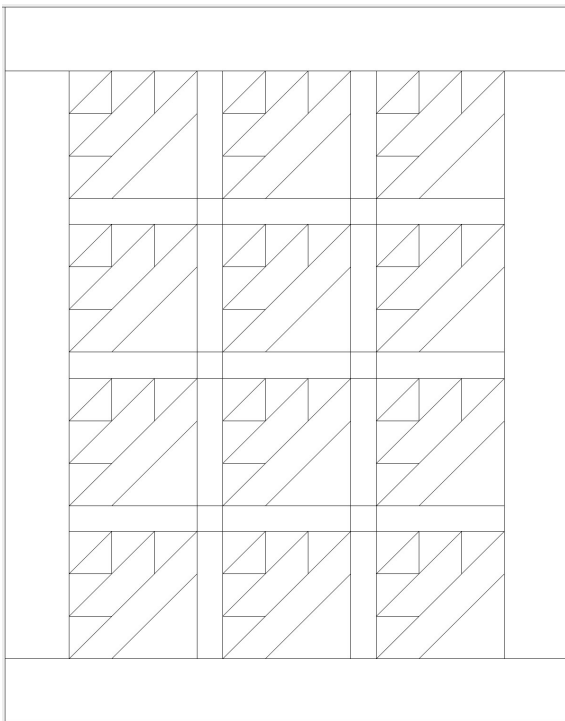
Sam Johnson and the Blue Ribbon Quilt



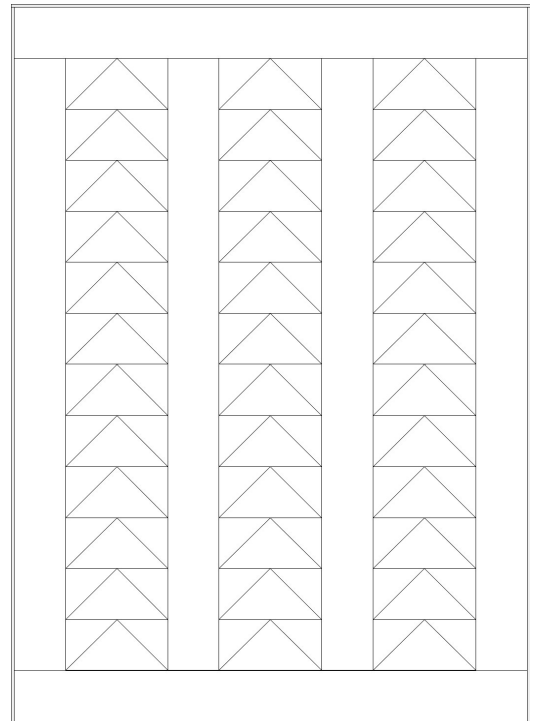
The Sailboat block was first named by Carrie Hall in the mid-1930's, during the Great Depression. Above is what the sailboat block looks like.



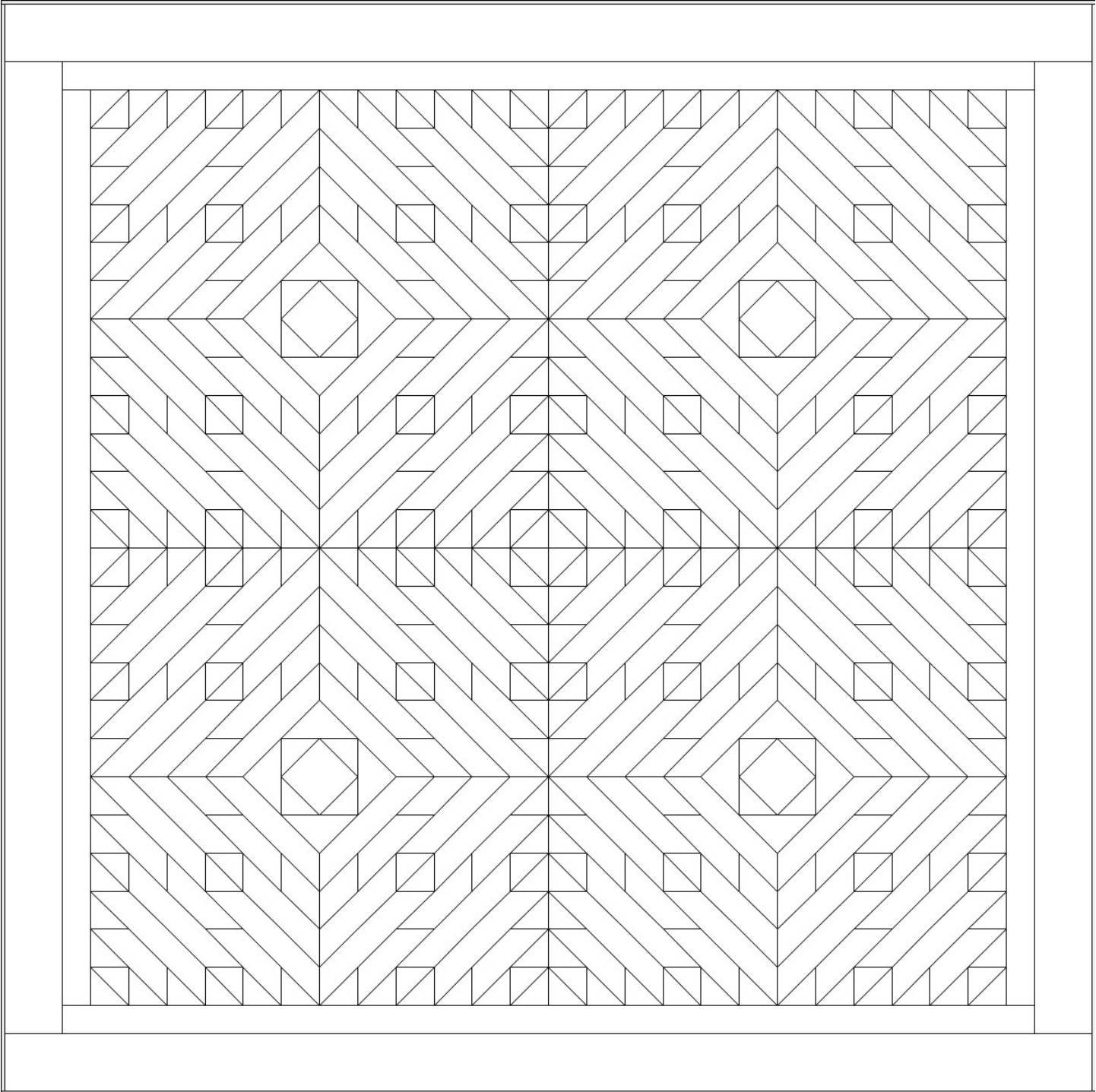
The Flying Geese block, from the same period, represents a goose flying against the sky. The goose is the center triangle and the sky is the two side triangles. Typically, the single goose block is twice as wide as it is tall. Above are two Flying Geese blocks.
